

SDSFA Policy of Individuals Rights.

An Individual Rights under the Jurisdiction and Governance of SDSFA Inc.

As per SDSFA Constitution Page 2 item 7. The jurisdiction of the association shall cover all association's officials, Clubs, teams, players, grounds, volunteers, employees, spectators, referees, match and competitions played within its boundaries.

SDSFA upon receiving written notice of a complaint from an individual in reference to any grievance that the individual may have with a member Club, will instruct the member Club to attend to the matter by conducting an investigation into the complaint, and afford the individual a hearing into their complaint.

The member Club must attend to all complaint matter referred back to them by SDSFA with the responsibility of the member Club furnishing any and all copies of correspondence for any investigation or resolution back to SDSFA Administration.

Individuals who have a grievance with a member Club in the first instance must receive a hearing from that member Club and upon completion of that hearing a written notice of the findings or resolutions of that hearing must be supplied to the individual.

Individuals, who are not satisfied with the resolutions or findings of the hearing of the member Club in the first instance, will have the right to appeal those resolutions or findings to SDSFA appeals Committee following the procedures of SDSFA appeals.

Member Clubs are to advise the individual of their rights and procedures of SDSFA appeals.
